- ★ Deadline to enter is March 23, 2012. Late entry is by April 6, 2012.

Parade Guidelines for Participants

*Thank you for choosing to participate
in the Founders Day Festival
Grande Parade.*

1. Use of Alcoholic beverages is strictly prohibited.
2. Non—parade vehicles are not allowed in the staging area. The staging area consists of Walnut Springs Elementary School Campus parking areas and roadways. Participants may be dropped off at the driveway entrances to the Elementary School campus, on Sportsplex Drive, and walk to their designated staging area.
3. Parade vehicles must enter the staging area using the main entrance to Walnut Springs, off Sportsplex Drive. Please observe the parade volunteer's instructions and directions.
4. Only those vehicles with an Official Entry Card will be allowed to enter the staging area. Those not holding an official entry card will not be able to participate.
5. **Official Entry Cards will be provided at a mandatory parade pre-meeting held on 4/12/2012 at 6:30pm at City Hall.** Every approved parade participant must send an adult representative to the pre-parade meeting. Those entries that have been approved, but do not attend the pre-parade meeting will not be allowed to participate. There will be no refunds for parade entries that have been approved and do not attend the pre-parade meeting.
6. Driving or parking vehicles on any grassy areas of the campus is absolutely prohibited.
7. Staging will begin at 4:30pm and vehicles will be allowed to enter until 6:00pm.
8. Each entry will receive their staging instructions at the meeting on 4/12/2012. It is the responsibility of the person attending the meeting to coordinate with the other members of their entry on where to meet for staging. Please observe the parade volunteer's instructions and directions as you enter the staging area.
9. Judging will begin at 5:30pm.
10. At the pre-parade meeting you will be give a **"Parade Participant Card"** that must be completed and returned as you enter the staging area the night of the parade. Completion of this card is required so that the Master of Ceremony may properly introduce your group.
11. If your entry includes animals, you are expected to have a waste detail walking immediately behind our group with the appropriate shovels and buckets. If you do not have the appropriate clean-up detail, entry in the parade will be denied.
12. If your entry includes animals, you are expected to maintain control of your animal at all times.
13. Riders not exhibiting control will be removed from the parade for their own and spectator safety.
14. **EACH ENTRY MUST HAVE A MINIMUM OF 2 ADULT SPOTTERS TO WALK THE ENTIRE PARADE ROUTE.** If you are throwing candy, you must have an ADULT SPOTTER on each side of the entry, at the front and at the back for a minimum of 4, to ensure spectators or children do not reach near or under the vehicles. Each spotter will be given a reflective vest to wear before the parade. Any entry not providing spotters will not be allowed to participate in the parade.
15. Candy must be thrown underhand and at the feet of the spectators. Any group throwing overhand or directly at a spectator will be asked to stop and will not be invited to participate in subsequent parades.
16. Follow the parade route and follow the instructions and directions of the Deputy Sheriff and Parade Officials. Do not ask to leave the parade route early.
17. If emergency vehicles need to leave the parade suddenly to answer an emergency, please get out of the way to facilitate their departure.
18. Participants are not allowed to get on or off your float or vehicle while it is in motion or anywhere on the parade route.
19. Do not allow participants to start dismantling your float until the float has returned to the staging area and is safely parked.
